

## **Sacred Journey (3–12)**

In this program, students explore the travelling exhibit Sacred Journey, created by the Heiltsuk First Nation. Students will learn about the annual Tribal Canoe Journeys hosted by coastal First Nations since 1993, its local connections to Campbell River, as well as Indigenous canoe cultures from around the world.
